Theme: "Â saluti! (Cheers! Good health!)"
Date: Saturday, March 14th, 2020, 10:00 am

The Independence Sicilian Heritage Festival (ISHF) invites you to participate in its 12th Annual Parade on Saturday, March 14th, 2020. The theme is " **saluti!** (Cheers! Good health!)". Floats are highly encouraged!

Check in time begins at 9:00 AM. The registration table will be located at the north end of Marretta St.

The parade will begin at 10:00 AM sharp, with formation on Marretta St., behind Independence High School. The parade will start at the corner of Marretta St. and Tiger Ave. and continue along the city approved route.

<u>Please note:</u> Hwy 51 will be closed to through traffic by order of the Louisiana Department of Transportation. Plan your entry into Independence accordingly!

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY Wednesday, March 11th, 2020.
- 2. The parade will be held rain or shine. There will be NO REFUNDS.
- 3. This year's theme is "Â saluti! (Cheers! Good health!)". We encourage all entries to include Italian music and decorate their floats according to the theme.
- 4. The following prize plaques will be awarded: 1st place for Best Decorated Float, 1st place for Best Decorated Vehicle, and 1st place for Best Marching Group. Judges will be chosen by The Independence Sicilian Heritage Festival.
- 5. Entries are to line up on Marretta St. via E 6th St.
- 6. Entries **must check in** at the **registration table** at the North end of Marretta St.
- 7. Entry numbers will be provided on a first-come first-served basis.
- 8. Parade participants will maintain numerical order and not trade with other entries.
- 9. Parade sponsors reserve the right to remove any inappropriate float(s) or people from participating in the parade.
- 10. When in motion, parade participants must maintain fifty (50) feet between entries.
- 11. Entries must complete a "Waiver, Indemnification and Release of Liability Agreement".
- 12. Control of motorized vehicles and animals must be maintained at all times.
- 13. All animals must be on a leash, lead, or rein. Owner(s) of all animals (including mounted horse entries) must provide their own cleanup crew equipped with their own appropriate scooper and broom.
- 14. Living entities on floats must be secured.
- 15. Sound entries will maintain volume not to interfere with other entries and Italian music is encouraged.
- 16. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 17. No consumption of alcoholic beverages while in the parade or in the staging area.
- 18. All parade participants must follow the direction of parade staff.

WAIVER, INDEMNIFICATION AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT

FOR GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, including permission to participate in the 12th Annual Independence Sicilian Heritage Festival Parade and any related activities, hereafter known as "Event": The affiliates, employees, volunteers, and any participants associated with _______ (name of Organization), hereafter known as "Participant", agrees to the following conditions, which shall apply to The Independence Sicilian Heritage Festival, the Town of Independence, its related entities, including sponsors of the event, their officers, directors, employees and volunteers, hereafter known as "Sponsor":

- 1. Upon arrival at **Event**, **Participant** will inspect the facilities, equipment and areas to be used, and, if believed to be unsafe, will immediately advise the supervisor of **Event**;
- 2. Participant acknowledges and has informed its affiliates that Event may involve risk of serious injury or death, including economic losses which may result not only from Participants' actions, inactions, or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, and the condition of the facilities, equipment, or areas where the Event being conducted;
- 3. **Participant** assumes any and all risks of personal injuries to **Participant**, including, but not limited to, medical or hospital bills, permanent or partial disability, death, and damage to property, caused by or arising from participation in **Event**;
- 4. **Participant** covenants not to sue or present any claim for personal injury property damage, or wrongful death against **Sponsor**;
- 5. Releases, waives, discharges and relinquishes **Sponsor** from any liability, loss damage, claim, demand or cause of action arising from or attributable negligence;
- 6. **Participant** acknowledges that photographs, pictures, slides, movies, or videos will be taken in connection with **Event**, without compensation by **Sponsor** to **Participant** and such media may be used for any legal purpose;
- 7. **Participant** warrants that all individuals affiliated with **Participant** are in good health and have no physical condition that would prevent such individuals from participating in this **Event**;
- 8. **Participant** acknowledges that **Sponsor** is not a joint sponsor, partner, or otherwise jointly engaged in the **Participant's** activities at the **Event**.

BY SIGNING BELOW, PARTICPANT IS REPRESENTING THAT IT HAS COMPREHENSIVE GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS THAT WOULD BE SUFFICIENT TO COVER COSTS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND ARISING FROM
